

Welcome!

Welcome to use my house! I hope you have a pleasant and relaxing stay. I've put together some information about the house you may find useful.

Kitchen, breakfast, tea and coffee

I've made some oat flakes, tea, coffee and sugar in the kitchen cupboards available for you. Feel free to use anything you find in the kitchen and refrigerator. There are some personal belongings in the freezer, please leave those as they are.

The kitchen counter tops have been recently renovated. Please be gentle with them and avoid things like heavy scrubbing or placing hot pans so they will last in good shape.

Wifi

In case of any issues, try turning the wifi router off and back on again.

Smoking and strong perfumes

Please take note that smoking is permitted only outdoors. If you do smoke outdoors, please collect up your cigarette butts.

Also please do not apply strong perfumes indoors (such as spray deodorants) as the smell can take a few weeks to clear up from the room which will not be appreciated by next guests.

Sauna and bathroom

The knob on the left turns on the sauna, for x hours. It takes about 20-30 minutes to heat up so that the sauna is ready to use. Turn the knob to about '2' position – this will turn the sauna on for two hours. In this position the '2' on the left knob is facing up. Turn it back to the original position (same as in picture) when you're done to turn off the sauna. The knob on the right regulates the temperature and is already adjusted.

After showering, please drain the shower hose by pulling the knob in the middle halfway so the shower will not drip any water on the floor and wipe water off the bathroom floor after last person has used it. This will make the bathroom dry faster as there is no floor heating installed.



Fireplace

The fireplace is an open model without a door so it tends to bring smoke indoors. I discourage from using it for that reason.

Bed linen and towels

There are sheets, pillows, duvets and towels in the lockers of the bedroom and the room next to the kitchen. I have already made the fixed beds. If you need to use the couches as extra beds, please use the linen from the lockers. Please use one set per person in to make sure there is fresh linen available also for next guests.

Personal belongings

As this is a house I also use, there are also some personal belongings here. In general, if you see an empty shelf (in the closets, in the freezer), feel free to use it and otherwise assume it is for personal belongings.

Things to see and do

I've collected some leaflets from nearby attractions and left them on the table. There are nature trails on the other side of highway (~1km walk). I can recommend visiting Ankkapurha rapids and nature trails in Anjala (~10km drive). There is also a nice cafe there. A bit further away, you might want to look up verla cardboard factory museum and Langinkoski imperial fishing cottage.

Shopping and groceries

The main nearby shops are:

- ABC Anjalankoski (~1km) – A “full service” gas station having a relatively decent restaurant as well as a small shop where you can get basic everyday things.
- S-market Sinikello (~3km) – The nearest supermarket, which is in Myllykoski. There are several other shops in Myllykoski as well, including a K supermarket and pizza and kebab restaurants.
- Lidl Inkeroinen (~6km) – A supermarket in Inkeroinen which is generally on the cheaper side. There are several other shops and services in Inkeroinen as well, including Tokmanni, some restaurants and K and S supermarkets.

Car charging

If you have an electric car, you can charge it overnight through the slow socket in the garage. Please limit the power to 2kW avoid any risk of wires overheating and an causing electrical fire (house is from 1978, before electric cars). Please inform me through an Airbnb message and leave 15 cents per used kWh on the living room table to pay for the used electricity.

Checking out

Check-out time is by 12:00. Please make sure the rear door is locked when leaving the house (turn the small knob to vertical position) and put both keys back inside the code lock using the code you checked in with. This is important so the cleaner can get in and set up the place for the next guests.

Please also empty the trash to the container next to the garage (in some cases the house may spend a few days by itself before it gets cleaned up for the next guests).

In case of issues / requests

Please contact me in case of any issues related to your stay. I'm doing my best to provide you an smooth and pleasant experience. If you would find any issues or things you need, feel free to contact me immediately and I will do my best to resolve them. I tend to notice the messages sent through airbnb within a few hours. If you need to reach me more urgently than that, please notify me by SMS or give me a call.
